Region meets next Saturday in Charlottesville. This will be my last time as RCM. Sue N. will be RCM after that so we will need an alternate. This was my second time being RCM and I totally enjoyed it. I got to know people from other areas and liked the sharing of new ideas. The requirements for alt. RCM are as follows: 3 years minimum clean time, 1 year area or group service experience, willingness to serve. It is a 1 year term, 2 year 6 month commitment (1 year as alternate RCM, 6 months as mentor. Must have a solid foundation of experience with the Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts. Attendance is required at every ASC.

Open positions at region are vice-chair. Requirements are 5 years clean time. 3 years area and or regional experience. Two year term, 4 year commitment. RDA2alt. Qualifications for this position: 4 years clean time, two years Area and /or Regional service experience. It is a two year term, 6 year commitment. PR Chair requirements are: 3 years clean time, 2 years Regional and or Area experience, two year commitment, and a solid foundation of the twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions, and Twelve Concepts. Also knowledge of Regional Guidelines and Rules of Order. Speaker Jam chair has same requirements.

It has been my pleasure to serve in this position and I thank the Area for allowing me this opportunity.
